

**ORDINANCE # 400-001**  
**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING VEHICLE SPEED IN THE CITY OF HEWITT**

The City Council of the City of Hewitt, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: No person shall drive a vehicle in the City of Hewitt at a speed that is greater than is reasonable and prudent under the conditions and having regard to actual and potential hazards then existing. In every event speed shall be so restricted as may be necessary to avoid colliding with any person, vehicle or other conveyance or on entering the highway in compliance with legal requirements and the duty of all persons to use due care.

SECTION 2: No person shall drive a vehicle within the City of Hewitt at a rate of speed in excess of twenty miles per hour, provided however that at any place within the City where a higher or lower rate of speed limit has been duly and lawfully set and indicated with appropriate traffic devices, no person shall drive a vehicle in excess of the rate so set.

SECTION 3: No person shall halt or drive a vehicle in such a slow speed as to impede or block normal and reasonable movement of traffic except when halting or reduced speed is necessary for safe operation or in compliance with law.

SECTION 4: Every driver of a vehicle shall bring the vehicle to a full complete stop before entering any through street or "stop" intersection, which has been properly designated and posted as such.

Passed by at least a 4/5ths majority vote of the City Council of the City of Hewitt, County of Todd and State of Minnesota, on this 24<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2009.
