

ORDINANCE # 500-001

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO DRUNKENNESS, DISORDERLY CONDUCT, INDECENT EXPOSURE, USING ANY OBSCENE LANGUAGE, HOUSES OF ILL-FAME, DISORDERLY HOUSES, AND FOR THE PRESERVATION OF THE PEACE, GOOD ORDER AND PUBLIC MORAL OF THE CITY

The City Council of the City of Hewitt, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: All brawling, obscene language or deportment, disorderly conduct, riot or riotous conduct, swearing, unusual and offensive noises, disturbances, fighting, quarreling, or breaches of the peace, in any building where the public is invited, or any public building, in or on any street, alley or other public place within the corporate limits of the City of Hewitt, and all shooting or discharging of firearms and willful, wanton and mischievous throwing of stones, sticks or other missiles, or the disturbance of any religious or other assembly within the corporate limits of the City of Hewitt, are hereby prohibited.

SECTION 2: No person shall keep a house of ill-fame, or any place resorted to for the purpose of prostitution, or lewdness, or keep a disorderly house, or place resorted to for immoral or disorderly purposes or aid or assist another in a manner in keeping such a house or place within the corporate limits of the City of Hewitt.

SECTION 3: No person shall in any of the streets, alleys or other public place, or exposed place, within the corporate limits of said City, make any indecent exposure of his or her person, or commit any obscene, indecent or filthy act, or appear in a state of nudity, or in any indecent or lewd dress, or be guilty of any indecent, lewd, immoral or insulting conduct or behavior whatever.

SECTION 4: Any person or persons violating any of the provisions of this Chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to penalty as set for in Ordinance #100-004.

SECTION 5: This Chapter shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.

Passed by at least a 4/5ths majority vote of the City Council of the City of Hewitt, County of Todd and State of Minnesota, on this 24th day of February, 2009.
