

ORDINANCE # 600-004
AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CATERERS IN THE CITY OF HEWITT

The City Council of the City of Hewitt, does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: Definition: Caterer's Permit shall be defined as a permit issued in accordance with Minnesota Statute 340A.404, Subdivision 12.

SECTION 2: Any person or entity possessing a caterer's permit in accordance with Minnesota Statute 340A.404 Subdivision 12, with an intent to conduct business within the corporate limits of the City of Hewitt shall first make application to the City Council of the City of Hewitt no less than 30 (thirty) days prior to the event to be catered.

SECTION 3: Upon making application to the City Council of the City of Hewitt, the applicant must appear at a regularly scheduled City Council Meeting, in which the City Council will vote upon the application, either granting or denying permission to conduct business in accordance with said permit. If permission is granted, the City will issue a permit to conduct business in accordance with all applicable laws, rules and regulations. Caterer must clearly and visibly display City-issued permit while conducting business within the corporate limits of the City of Hewitt.

SECTION 4: Separate application must be made for each and every separate event.

SECTION 5: Any person conducting business within the corporate limits of the City of Hewitt shall abide by all applicable Federal, State and Local Laws and Ordinances.

SECTION 6: Any violation of applicable laws and/or ordinances shall constitute grounds for immediate revocation of permit.

SECTION 7: Council has full authority to set additional guidelines or restrictions and may do so on a case-by-case basis, by a majority vote of the City Council of the City of Hewitt.

SECTION 4: Any person, persons or entity violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to penalty as set forth in Ordinance #100-004.

Passed by at least a 4/5ths majority vote of the City Council of the City of Hewitt, County of Todd and State of Minnesota, on this — day of April, 2009.
